TERMS:

By signing below, you are making a full commitment to participate in Sausage and Cider Fest 2017 and agree to follow these terms and those listed on the vendor guidelines document. Vendors who do not honor this commitment may not be allowed to participate in future festivals.

- You agree to staff your booth at all times during the festival. Staff must be 21 or older if providing alcohol.
- You understand that you are responsible for abiding by all state laws, health department guidelines, and liquor control guidelines that are valid for your type of business/organization and have all necessary permits required. The festival does hold a special occasion permit from the Washington State Liquor Control Board for this event as well as a special event permit issued by the City of Covington.
- You understand that we reimburse you for the amount of beverage you pour for sampling at the wholesale cost. Payments are normally issued within one week after event.
- You understand and agree that sample sizes are a 2-ounce pour. Each 2-ounce pour costs attendees one ticket. (A 4-ounce pour would cost 2 tickets, etc.)
- You understand that the festival will cross check your estimated volume poured based on how many tickets you have accepted and turn in at the end of the event. If a sizeable discrepancy exists, the vendor will be reimbursed based on the number of tickets accepted and turned in.
- You understand if a new keg or bottle has been opened, but remains partly unused by the end of the event and you cannot salvage it for future use, you will be reimbursed for the full keg/bottle wholesale cost as long as tickets accepted and estimated volume poured are similar.
